Throughout the week, students enjoyed a range of interactive activities in the foyer during their break times—including collaborative mural making, bookmark creation, comic strip design, and book cover illustration. The cozy Reading Garden, complete with beanbags and a wide selection of books and audiobooks, provided a peaceful space for students to relax and immerse themselves in a good story. Additionally, older students had the opportunity to read to younger students and vice versa, fostering a love for storytelling and strengthening the school's reading community.

Sengho Book Company also participated by displaying a collection of books for students to explore and purchase. This gave students the opportunity to browse new titles, discover different genres, and bring home books that sparked their interest, further enriching their reading experience.

Each class also participated in our Student Author Project, where they collaboratively wrote and illustrated their own books. 
