Primary Academic Updates

In Weeks 13 and 14, students in Grades 2–6 will complete short Literacy and Numeracy assessments using eGrader, a Finnish digital tool that helps teachers track student progress.

These are not formal tests, just a way for teachers to better understand each student's learning and plan next steps. The information gathered will help us continue to tailor teaching and support steady progress for all students.

We have also introduced **Flexible Grouping** for **Reading in Grades 1–2**, following the Finnish model. This allows teachers to group students according to their current reading needs so that every child receives the right level of challenge and support. The sessions will take place every second week, and we will gradually build them up as students and teachers become more familiar with the process.

Both initiatives reflect our commitment to responsive, personalised learning that supports every child's growth.
