



Building a Sustainable Community at Finnway International School

On Wednesday, 28 January, Finnway International School hosted a community meeting linked to our Term 2 theme of sustainable development. The focus of the afternoon was on recycling, reusing everyday items, and strengthening our sense of community around these important goals.

We invited representatives from local organisations to share concrete examples of how items can be given a second life and the kinds of recycling initiatives that already exist in our neighbourhood.
