## End of Term 2 – Parent/Teacher Meetings

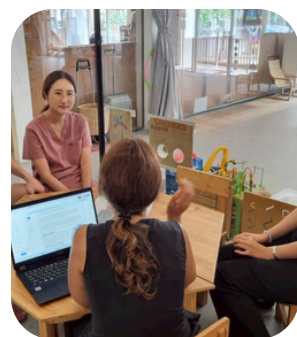


As we come to the end of Term 2, we would like to extend our sincere thank you to all our parents who took the time to join the ECEC discussions with our teachers.
