Swimming Program

This programme will take place during the regular school day at no additional cost and will begin in Week 2. Swimming sessions will take place on students' regular PE days. Students will be transported by bus from school to the swimming pool location and back.

As the pool is outdoors, please also ensure that sunblock is applied at home before arriving at school. Students may either wear their swimwear underneath their school uniform or bring it to change into at school. They should also bring a change of clothes and a plastic bag for wet items.
