Strengthening Student Health and Wellbeing



At Finnway International School Phuket, the health, safety, and wellbeing of our students remain a top priority. As part of our ongoing commitment to providing a safe and supportive learning environment, Teacher Nut, Teacher Au, Teacher Pao, and Khun Muk recently participated in the “Back to School: A Healthy Start to the New School Term” training programme.

The training was organised through the Health Buddy @ School Initiative, a collaborative programme between schools and the Bangkok Hospital Network in Phuket Province. Finnway is proud to be one of the participating schools working together to strengthen student health and wellbeing within the school community.

During the training, participants gained valuable knowledge and practical skills in:

1. Managing Infectious Diseases in Children During the School Term
 - * Recognising common infectious diseases among school-aged children
 - * Student health screening and appropriate response procedures
 - * Preventing and reducing the spread of illness within the school environment
2. Child Care and Health Monitoring Workshop
 - * Supporting children's daily health and wellbeing
 - * Enhancing staff readiness to respond appropriately to students' health needs
3. Telehealth Services in Schools
 - * Exploring innovative healthcare consultation services
 - * Improving access to timely medical advice and professional support

By investing in continuous professional learning, Finnway ensures that our staff are equipped with the knowledge and confidence to promote a healthy, safe, and caring environment where every child can thrive.

Strengthening SEN Support Through Collaboration

Our SEN team visited Kajonkiet International School for a professional exchange on student support, assessments and inclusive practices. We discussed practical ways to guide parents toward early support through clear data, observations and assessments.

The meeting also highlighted different Learning Support Assistant models, including shared LSA support for small groups of students, as well as positive experiences of using LSAs for EAL support. Local assessment options, such as Marble Psychology, Pingi and Maximise, were also discussed.

Another useful idea was a parent workshop on children's device use, focusing not only on screen-time limits but also on co-watching and adult guidance.

The visit gave us valuable ideas for strengthening SEN support through early intervention, parent partnership and collaboration with external professionals.
